Parenting Tip of the Month Early Years Development Stages

Stages of Play Ages 3-5 years

Understanding the Stages of Play - Children move through different stages of play as they grow. Each stage supports learning and development in its own way:

Parallel – Playing beside other children without interaction.

Tip: Great for toddlers learning to be around peers.

Associative – Playing near others with some interaction.

Tip: Encourage sharing and simple group activities.

• Cooperative – Playing together with shared goals.

Tip: Support teamwork through games and imaginative play.

These stages are part of healthy development, and children typically move through them at their own pace.

Edible Crafts for Kids



Marshmallow playdough (no-cook)

Ingredients:

 12 large marshmallows, 2 teaspoons coconut oil, and 8 tablespoons cornstarch

Instructions:

- In a microwave-safe bowl, combine marshmallows and coconut oil.
- Microwave on high for about 30 seconds, or until the marshmallows puff up slightly.
- Add a few drops of food colouring and mix well.
- Stir in the cornstarch until a thick dough forms.
- Knead on a clean surface, adding more cornstarch if needed, until the dough is pliable but not sticky.

Seasons of the Moon

Tempó:kw - October 26 - November 24 - Time to smoke Chehalis Spring Salmon


It's Fall in the Fraser Valley. Nighttime comes earlier than it did in the summer and rainwater replenishes our rivers, lakes, and streams. The rivers get stronger this time of year and the salmon begin swimming upriver. In Stó:lō Territory, this is the start of the Stó:lō New Year. Tempo:kw' means "time for Chehalis Spring Salmon"; **tem** means time or season and **po:kw'** means Chehalis River spring salmon. This type of salmon begins to run about October and is smoke dried in smokehouses during this month.
